

Policy Statement

To achieve these objectives, it is Monsal's policy to implement and maintain an Environmental Management System that fully meets the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001:2004 .

MBOS is subject to regular internal and external audit and is open to audit by our clients.

Our objective for environmental management is to deliver our projects with zero reportable incidents and to document, and learn from all 'near misses'. Supply chain management is critical to achieving this and Monsal will seek to improve the performance of internal and subcontract staff and suppliers by adopting partnership working styles and improving education, all within a clear command structure.

The Monsal Business Plan is supported by this policy and we will not hesitate to amend existing, or implement new, working practices to ensure the continual improvement of our products, services and management systems. This policy will be reviewed, approved by the Monsal Board of Directors, re-signed and dated annually as a minimum.
